Walk/ Bike Procedures for Corvian Students at the Middle School/High School

Students must have a Walk/Bike Permission form filled out and signed by their parents. This form must be on file in the office for students to be able to walk/bike to and from school.

Morning Procedures for Middle School- all MS students will enter through the high school exit

- 1. Students should make every effort to arrive at school during morning carpool (7:40-8:00am). A carpool worker will be stationed at the middle school driveway to help the students cross the driveway. Students will then be directed to the high school exit where a carpool worker will direct them to walk their bikes down the sidewalk. Once they reach the end of the sidewalk, a high school carpool worker will direct the students where to cross. Once the student is on the middle school driveway they will walk on the sidewalk to the bike rack in the front of the building.
- 2. If a student arrives prior to 7:40 am, they will be expected to immediately sign in at the front desk and remain in the office. Seating will be available.
- 3. Students are NOT permitted to leave the front office until morning carpool begins, at which time they may walk to class.

<u>Afternoon Procedure for Middle School</u>- all MS students will exit through the middle school exit

- At 3:00 pm all walkers and bikers will be called to carpool. Walkers and bikers will sign themselves out at the front desk and report to the flagpole. Students will be asked to walk their bikes on the sidewalk.
- A staff member will escort students from the Corvian sidewalk to Johnston Oehler Road.
- Once students have been escorted to the sidewalk along Johnston Oehler Road, they will be permitted to make their way home.

Biking or Walking to School (HS)

Students in grades 9-12 are permitted to ride their bike or walk to school provided they complete the form on the school website and follow all expectations. Students will enter at the 2nd driveway (exit) and must walk their bikes along the sidewalk once they reach the school. Violations will be handled on a case by case basis and may result in the revocation of biking or walking privileges for the remainder of the school year.

Students may enter the high school beginning at 7 am and must report to the downstairs commons area. They must be seated and find something to do until the bell rings to dismiss them to class at 7:55.

Students may leave during dismissal in the afternoon and must walk their bikes on the sidewalks until they get to Johnston Oehler Road.
